

#### 1. Purpose

Under Standard 8 of the Education Services for Overseas Students (ESOS) Act 2000 (Cth), National Code of Practice for Registration Authorities and Providers of Education and Training to Overseas Students 2018 (National Code 2018) international students must make satisfactory course progress as a condition of their student visa.

Melbourne Polytechnic as a registered provider must

- monitor the international student's course progress and attendance
- identify and offer support to those at risk of not meeting course progress or attendance requirements
- only extend the duration of an international student's enrolment in certain circumstances and
- advise international students of potential impacts on their student visa
- must inform overseas students before they begin a course about the requirements to achieve satisfactory course progress

This procedure defines Melbourne Polytechnic's minimum requirements for achieving satisfactory course progress for all full-time CRICOS registered courses offered to international student visa holders at Melbourne Polytechnic.

This procedure applies to international students, staff in International and staff in teaching departments.

#### 2. Definitions

<u>CRICOS</u>: Commonwealth Register of Institutions and Courses for Overseas Students

<u>International Student</u>: As defined in the Student Enrolment, Fees and Charges Policy and Education Services for Overseas Students Act 2000 (ESOS Act); student who holds a Student Visa
