Who can help me at Melbourne Polytechnic?

Compliance/Welfare Officer - International office

Melbourne Polytechnic's Compliance/Welfare Officer is the person you can contact if you require assistance with any issue relating to your Guardianship or Homestay while you are studying at Melbourne Polytechnic.

Melbourne Polytechnic's Compliance/Welfare Officer can help you with questions you have about your visa, your attendance/academic progress, and, where required, refer you to other Melbourne Polytechnic staff who will be able to help you.

Melbourne Polytechnic's Compliance/Welfare Officer is located in the International Office on the ground floor of Building A at Preston Campus.

What services are available at Melbourne Polytechnic?

What do I do if I am sick?

Please inform your Homestay Host if you are sick. If you are unable to attend classes for more than two days in a row you need to contact your Guardian and Melbourne Polytechnic's Compliance/ Welfare Officer.



I need to ask a question about Homestay

What are the Homestay rules?

Your Guardian will go through Homestay provider's set of rules which you must follow. If you need a copy of these rules, please you're your Guardian.

You should always feel comfortable to speak with your Homestay Host if you have a question about your Homestay.

Can I move to a different Homestay?

Discuss any intention to change Homestay address with your Guardian. Your Guardian will assist you with the change/move. You must inform Melbourne Polytechnic's Compliance/Welfare Officer about the change of Homestay address.



How do I gain approval to go on a holiday away from Homestay?

You need to speak to your Homestay Host and appointed Guardian if you plan to stay overnight at an address other than your Homestay address.

If you are going on a holiday or plan to be away from your Homestay for more than two days in a row, you must inform your Guardian and Melbourne Polytechnic's Compliance /Welfare Officer.



If I want to go home to my country, who do I tell?

If you want to go home for a short holiday you need to discuss this with your Homestay Host, your Guardian and Melbourne Polytechnic's Compliance/Welfare Officer. You are required to apply for either an Application for Deferment or an Application for Leave if you need to return home during the period of your CoE.

If you wish to return home and not return to Australia you need to discuss this with your Guardian, Homestay Host and Melbourne Polytechnic's Compliance/Welfare officer.



Who gives me permission to go on an excursion?

Your Guardian and Homestay Host must sign your excursion form every time you need to attend an excursion. As soon as you are told about an excursion, you need to contact your Guardian and homestay Host to organise your excursion permission.
