VILLARNAU CAVA BRUT RESERVA NV

'Cava' is Spain's equivalent to champagne. Macabeo, Parellada and Xarello grapes are blended to create a medium dry style with notes of apple, pear, lemon and those biscuit, toasty characteristics, which come from secondary fermentation. A versatile sparkling that is food friendly.

JOHN GEHRIG SPARKLING MERLOT NV

Merlot is a very friendly red grape for the production of sparkling wine. This wine from John Gehrig offers soft tannins and sweet berry flavours, and has both the depth and character to be enjoyed with white and red meat dishes.

ALEXANDER HILL FRUITY LEXIA
- Yeringa, New South Wales

This is a fruit driven wine with light carbonation. It's made using the Muscat grape, which typically delivers aromas of citrus, orange blossom, and honeysuckle. There some acidity to balance out the fruitiness.

TAHBILK RIESLING
- Goulburn River, Central Victoria

This example has a gentle, light body with floral aromas. It's not "steely" like others from around the country, offering a textured palate, with good acidity and citrus flavours. It is "moreish" and would compliment lighter dishes and seafood well.

DAL ZOTTO PINOT GRIGIO
- King Valley, Victoria

This family owned winery is located in an ideal location for growing Italian grape varieties. Pinot Grigio is easy drinking with flavours of fresh lime and pear with a hint of nuttiness. There is a nice textural mouthfeel which allows it to match well with seafood and lighter dishes.

2018 ADEGA PAZOS DE LUSCO ALBARINO
- Rias Baixias, Spain

The Albarino grape is a native variety to Galicia in the north west of Spain. This aged example offers plenty of texture, with spicy lemon and quince notes. It's still supported with acidity and is a great accompaniment to seafood dishes.

VILLA MARIA PRIVATE BIN
SAUVIGNON BLANC
– Marlborough, New Zealand

Villa Maria sources grapes from the two regions of Marlborough; the cooler Awatere and warmer Wairau valleys to produce this quality example of Sauvignon Blanc. Perfumed aromas of lime, snow peas and fresh herbs compliment a rich palate of passionfruit, melon and ruby grapefruit.

EVANS & TATE METRICUP ROAD
CHARDONNAY
– Margaret River, Western Australia

Margaret River is well known for its world class chardonnay wines. This Chardonnay has aromas of white peach, lemon citrus and melon. There is subtle oak integration which provides creaminess and richness to the palate. Great with white meats, seafood and rich soft cheeses.

TOKAR ESTATE CHARDONNAY
– Yarra Valley, Victoria

The Yarra Valley is well known for its quality chardonnay and this is another good example. Aromas of white peach lead nicely to flavours of stone fruit, green apple and lime. The length of palate is long and the acid structure is good, allowing the wine to finish very cleanly.

Jim Barry "Annabelle's" ROSE
– Clare Valley, South Australia

Jim Barry winery is a top Australian producer and this rose is named after the maker's grand daughter. The blend of red grapes consist of mataro (mouvedre), shiraz, merlot and grenache. This combination delivers red fruits and cream. There is also a good line of acidity to provide structure and balance. It's moreish!

ST HUBERTS "The Stag" PINOT NOIR – Yarra Valley, Victoria

Using fruit from the renowned Yarra Valley region, this wine delivers aromas of bright fruits such as strawberry, raspberry and cherry, supported by oak and spice. The palate offers flavours of dark cherry, oak and spice. Some acidity and soft tannins leave the wine with a medium dry finish.

FOWLES WINE "Ladies Who Shoot Their Lunch" PINOT NOIR – Strathbogie Ranges, Victoria

The growing conditions for the vintage were extremely favourable and hence produced a pinot noir of great balance. The palate delivers bright red fruits with good structure, fine tannins, acidity and excellent length. The final wine also consists of an addition of Mouverdre for flavour and colour, and Sangiovese for complexity and savoury characteristics.

ALKOOMI SHIRAZ VIOGNIER – Frankland River, Western Australia

Alkoomi is a top family owned producer located in southern Western Australia (inland and east from Margaret River). This wine is aged in French oak for 12 months resulting in a full bodied style offering licorice, spice, blackberry and structure from the tannins. The Viognier (white grape) is used to add floral notes to the bouquet and take the edge off the tannins.

JOHN GEHRIG 'SNART'S BLOCK' SHIRAZ – King Valley, Victoria

Snarts block refers to the original winemaking pioneer, Robert Snart, who established a vineyard & winery back in 1860 on the current site. This central Victorian example has a complex bouquet of black pepper, black olive, dried meat and spicy vanilla cedar. The palate is "chewy" and has richness with black cherry, licorice and pepper. A perfect wine for red meat dishes and hard cheeses.

PREECE 'HEATCOTE' SHIRAZ – Heathcote, Victoria

Heathcote represents a region from which some of Australia's best examples of shiraz are produced. The red soil unique to the area produces a fruit driven style, that is rich and smooth. The Preece shiraz offers a bouquet of licorice, blackberries, chocolate and spice. The palate is smooth with layers of plum, ripe blackberries and licorice. It's well balanced with soft tannins build and the finish has length.

TAHBILK CABERNET SAUVIGNON – Nagambie Lakes, Central Victoria

A structured wine from one of the oldest family owned wineries in Australia. The estate is also certified as carbon neutral. This cabernet has aromas of intense blackberry, spice, black olive and dried herbs. The black olive character is unique to cabernet from that area. The palate is medium bodied and fresh, delivering flavours of blackcurrant and black olive. The wine has medium tannins and the finish is dry and long. Great with red meat dishes and hard cheeses.

2012 BODEGAS BERONIA RIOJA RISERVSA – Rioja Alta, Spain

Red wines from Rioja always use the Tempranillo grape in the blend. This wine is matured in both American and French oak for 20 months. The resulting wine displays aromas of coconut, spices and cedar. The palate starts with blackberry fruit and then offers dryness and texture. Spanish wine laws ensure that the quality of the Rioja style is kept very high. Rioja pairs very well with red meat, especially lamb.

BOTRYTIS RIESLING – Goulburn River,
Central Victoria (375ml)

Deep gold in colour and bursting with aromas of candied citrus, dried fruits and lime marmalade. The palate is thick and luscious and resplendent with flavours of ginger spice, raisins and honeysuckle.

TAHBILK CANE CUT MARSANNE
– Nagambie Lakes, Central Victoria

Once the canes are cut from the vine, the Marsanne grape is allowed to ripen. The result is a concentrated yet balanced sweet wine showing honeysuckle, tangerine, cumquat marmalade and lemon.
