At enrolment, all students seeking government funding are required to complete a short literacy and numeracy assessment.

Successful completion of one year full-time study will qualify you in Certificate IV in Interior Decoration (MSF40113).

Successful completion of an additional 6 months of full-time study will result in you gaining the Diploma of Interior Design and Decoration (MSF50213).
